ALPHA DELTA KAPPA PEARLS OF ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Chapters earn "pearls" from June 1 through May 31 each year. One **pearl**, up to a maximum of seven pearls, is awarded for the attainment of each of the criteria as identified on the A Δ K Pearls of Achievement Award Checklist. A chapter will be recognized as a 7 "pearl" chapter if it meets all seven of the criteria: a 6 "pearl" chapter if it meets any six criteria, etc.

Chapters will be recognized annually with a "Pearls of Achievement" certificate. The specific

"Pearl" designation earned by each chapter will be reported on the Alpha Delta Kappa International website.


