MEMBERSHIP STARTS WITH ME

New Member Registration Video: Go to the International Website. This video is 5:48 minutes. It was developed by Jamie Hinck and Terry Payon. They show the step-by-step process to register a new member.

To register a NEW MEMBER: (To be done on the day of Initiation)

Type in the Alpha Delta Kappa.org URL.

Click on the MEMBERSHIP tab.

- 1. Complete the "Create an Account" section.
- 2. Provide sponsor information. (You will need your sponsor's member ID number, which can be found on their member profile.)
- 3. Create a personal user name and password.
- 4. Complete professional and educational information.
- 5. Sign the membership ethics statement.
- 6. Choose payment method.
- 7. Pay international new member dues using PayPal or credit card.

A credit card other than the new members card can create an issue. The computer automatically populates the new member's name and the address for the credit card information. Delete her information and use the name and address on the credit card you are using. Otherwise, the new member will not be registered and will not appear on the chapter roster.
